Camp Descriptions

Week One: May 28 - May 31 –Drawing

Campers will draw from life objects, photographs, lines, shapes, and lighting. During this camp we will use oil pastels, pencils, color pencils, markers, and charcoal.

Week Two: May 30 - June 2 – Painting

Campers will be introduced to the color wheel and learn how to mix colors. Campers will also learn to use a variety of mediums to engage in painting.

Week Three: June 10 – June 14 – Mary Cassatt & Her Art

Campers will explore the art of American Artist, Mary Cassatt, and some of her famous pastel pieces. Campers will have the opportunity to create masterpieces of their own.

Week Four: June 17 – June 21 – Drawing

Campers will draw from life objects, photographs, lines, shapes, and lighting. During this camp, campers will use pastels, pencils, color pencils, and markers.

Week Five: June 24 – June 28 – 3-D

Campers will create a 3-dimensional piece of art using foam core. Campers may also get an opportunity to create a collage with their art pieces.

Week Six: July 8 – July 12 – Nature

Campers will design an art piece using objects found in nature, such as tree limbs or branches. If time permits, campers may incorporate rubbings of nature objects from outdoors.

Week Seven: July 15 – July 19 – Painting

Campers will be introduced to the color wheel how to mix colors. Also, during this week campers will learn to use a variety of mediums to engage in painting.

Week Eight: July 22 – July 26 – Cartoon Drawing

Campers will learn to draw cartoon objects by using realism. During this camp, Campers will learn how to distort realism into fantasy through the use of art.

All camps will have the opportunity to do a clay project with the exception of Week one, which is only a four-day camp.
